ECONOMY/AUSTERITY MEASURES FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2016-17

Dear Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to say that the Provincial Cabinet in its meeting held on 14.06.2016 while considering the Budget Estimates 2016-17, approved the following guiding principles to curtail the recurring expenditure, to be effective from 1st July, 2016:-

- 1) There shall be complete ban on creation of posts except posts required for completed Developmental Projects.
- 2) There shall be complete ban on treatment abroad on Provincial Government's expense.
- 3) There shall be complete ban on purchase of new vehicles.
- 4) Participation in workshops/seminars and training abroad involving provincial funds will be banned.
- There shall be complete ban on holding Seminars and Workshops in Five Star Hotels involving Provincial funds.
- All Administrative Secretaries and Heads of Autonomous/Semi-Autonomous Bodies, being Principal Accounting Officers, shall conduct meetings of Departmental Accounts Committee regularly under intimation to Finance Department so as to ensure INTERNAL AUDIT of their respective Departments /Organizations.
- 7) To achieve the budgeted Provincial Revenue targets, Finance Department shall convene monthly meetings to be attended by administrative Secretaries of the concerned Departments.
- 8) No appointment of contingent paid staff shall be made during the course of the financial year 2016-17.
- 9) No appointment shall be made against leave vacancies without prior approval of Finance Department.
- 10) No appointment will be made against vacant posts (except Class-IV) without obtaining NOC from the concerned Surplus Pool."

- Principal Accounting Officers will make sure that no appointment is made against a vacant post of dying cadre and will also initiate disciplinary action if any such appointments have been made previously.
- **20%** cut shall be imposed on the **non-salary budget**. Any relaxation of this cut will have to be approved by the Chief Minister.
- Expenditure shall be restricted to the funds released and the Administrative Departments shall not incur expenditure in anticipation of additional grants or supplementary grant.
- 14) No developmental scheme involving creation of posts will be considered without prior clearance of Finance Department.
- No department shall retain receipts in Bank Accounts. The Departments must remit all Receipts to Provincial Account forthwith except where Departments/facilities have been specifically permitted under some Statute/Act.
- No funds will be utilized on account of annual and special **repair** of such **Roads & Buildings** which have been repaired / rehabilitated during **last three years** except flood and earthquake affected Government infrastructure.
- The advertisement charges allocated under Current Revenue Expenditure shall be utilized on Current Budget side only. As regards expenditure on Developmental Side, necessary provision will be made in the PC-I(s)/Costs Estimate(s) of the concerned scheme(s) whereas the devolved Department's expenditure on this account shall be met out of Account-IV of the District concerned.
- 18) The Autonomous Medical Teaching Institutions, other institutions and Authorities under Provincial Government should adopt the measures within their respective organizations with approval of their concerned boards.
- 2. The above Economy/Austerity Measures for the financial year 2016-17 may kindly be implemented in letter and spirit.
